City of Vernon Economic Development Rate Tariff

A Program Summary

The City of Vernon has established an Economic Development Rate Tariff (EDRT) to encourage new customers to locate their business operations in Vernon. The city's new EDRT will additionally provide benefits to current Light & Power customers that expand their business operations and enlarge their commercial footprint within Vernon.

As an incentive to encourage new business activity, Vernon's Economic Development Rate Tariff provides a five-year reduction of up to twenty percent (20%) on a customer's otherwise applicable tariff (OAT), excluding taxes. The potential rate reduction would be calculated on the rate components of a customer's bill that correlates to city services provided to the customer.

Eligible customers include those currently on or electing existing schedules: TOU-G, or TOU-V, or their successor rate schedule. New customers with maximum billing demands greater than 100 kW, or existing customers who add at least 100 kW of demand, may qualify for the new Vernon EDRT.

Vernon's new EDRT demonstrates our city's commitment to its customers. We will continue to pursue innovative approaches that support growth and success for businesses throughout the City of Vernon.
