- Demolition** (demolition of all or a portion of an existing building or structure)
- Electrical** (electrical systems or any equipment that is electrically driven)
- Fire Alarm** (monitoring systems for fire)
- Fire Extinguishing System** (sprinklers, suppression, etc)
- Fire Hazardous Materials** (removal of tanks, installation of tanks, etc)
- Fire Miscellaneous** (high pile storage, protector wire, etc)
- Grading** (earthwork and paving of a site)
- Industrial Addition** (An addition to the exterior of an existing building or structure)
- Industrial New** (standalone newly constructed building or structure)
- Industrial Remodel** (An modification to the interior or exterior of an existing building)
- Industrial Wastewater** (Processing of a LACSD wastewater permits)
- Mechanical** (HVAC sys, refrigeration sys, gas fired equip., ducts, boilers, airlines, gas lines, etc.)
- Miscellaneous** (storage rack system, signs, fences, equipment foundation, etc)
- Plumbing** (water, sewer, storm drains, plumbing fixtures, clarifiers, water heaters, interceptors)
- Roofing*** (removing, replacing, repairing, etc)
- Trailer** (construction trailer, temporary trailer)
- Commercial Addition** (addition to the exterior of an existing building or structure)
- Commercial New** (standalone newly constructed building or structure)
- Commercial Remodel** (modification to the interior or exterior of an existing building)
- Multi / Residential Addition** (addition to the exterior of a existing building)
- Multi / Residential New** (standalone newly constructed building or structure)
- Multi / Residential remodel** (modification to the interior of an exiting building)

*** Permit must be submitted with the Roofing Requirements and Questionnaire form upon submittal. In addition, a separate Miscellaneous permit may be required for asbestos removal.**

Permit Definitions

- Addition** An addition is added structure to the exterior of an existing building. This includes a canopy that is both supported off of the building and also from the ground. A canopy that is totally supported from the building would be considered a remodel.
- Commercial** Commercial uses includes buildings used exclusively for office use, retail use or commercial uses such as banks, restaurants, print shop and other similar uses. A commercial use typically provides a service to an individual or a business.
- Electrical** An electrical permit is required for the installation of any electrical systems or any equipment that is electrically driven. If the equipment needs a foundation or an upgrade to the buildings structural system to support the equipment a separate building permit shall be obtained.
- Grading** Includes both earthwork and paving of a site.
- Industrial** For the purposes of building permits an industrial building permit is for all buildings used for manufacturing, warehouse, wholesale recycling or similar uses.
- Mechanical** A mechanical permit is required for the installation of any mechanical equipment, such as HVAC systems, refrigeration systems, gas fired equipment, vents and ducts, boilers and gas, air and steam lines. If the equipment needs a foundation or an upgrade to the buildings structural system to support the equipment a separate building permit shall be obtained.
- Miscellaneous**-Includes the installation of storage rack systems, signs, fences, site walls and improvements for the installation of equipment including foundations, structural strengthening of the building to support the equipment and equipment platforms and asbestos removal.
- New** Is a standalone newly constructed building or structure with a roof covering. This includes a self-supported canopy.
- Plumbing** A plumbing permit is required for any water, sewer and storm drainage lines, plumbing fixtures, clarifiers, interceptors and water heaters (excluding boilers).
- Remodel** A remodel includes tenant improvements to the office components of a building including the installation of new doors and windows, relocation or installation of new walls and ceilings and ADA disability improvements. Remodel includes the construction of new interior offices and mezzanines and the construction of canopies fully supported by the building. A remodel also includes the seismic strengthening of a structure.

OWNER - BUILDER DECLARATION

I hereby affirm under penalty of perjury that I am exempt from the Contractor's License Law for the following reason (Sec. 7031.5, California Business and Professions Code: Any city or county which requires a permit to construct, alter, improve, demolish, or repair any structure, prior to its issuance, also requires that the applicant for such permit to file a signed statement that he or she is licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Contractor's License Law (Chapter 9, commencing with Section 7000 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code) or that he or she is exempt therefrom and the basis for the alleged exemption. Any violation of Section 7031.5 by any applicant for a permit subjects the applicant to a civil penalty of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500)):

I, as owner of the property, or my employees with wages as their sole compensation, will do the work, and the structure is not intended or offered for sale (Sec. 7044, Business and Professions Code: The Contractors License Law does not apply to an owner of a property who builds or improves thereon, and who does such work himself or herself or through his or her employees, provided that such improvements are not intended or offered for sale. If, however, the building or improvement is sold within one year of completion, the owner-builder will have the burden of proving that he or she did not build or improve for the purpose of sale).

I, as owner of the property, am exclusively contracting with licensed contractors to construct the project (Sec. 7044, Business and Professions code: The Contractors License Law does not apply to an owner of property who builds or improves thereon, and who contracts for such projects with a subcontractor or subcontractors licensed pursuant to the Contractors License Law).

IMPORTANT: APPLICATION IS HEREBY MADE TO THE BUILDING OFFICIAL FOR A PERMIT SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS SET FORTH ON THIS APPLICATION AND THE FOLLOWING:

1. The City's approved plans and permit inspection card must remain on the job site for use by City inspection personnel.
2. Final inspection of the work authorized by this permit is required. A Certificate of Occupancy must be obtained prior to use and occupancy of new buildings or additions.
3. Each person upon whose behalf this applications is made and each person at whose request and for whose benefit work is performed under or pursuant to any permit issued as a result of this application agrees to, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Vernon, it's officers, agents and employees in accordance with the provisions of Section 24.2 of the municipal code of the City of Vernon.
4. This permit/plan review expires by time limitation and becomes null and void if the work authorized by the permit is not commenced within 180 days from the date of permit issuance or if the permit is not obtained within 180 days from the date of plan submittal. This permit expires and becomes null and void if any work authorized by this permit is suspended or abandoned for 180 consecutive days or if no progressive work has been verified by a City building inspector for a period of 180 consecutive days.

CERTIFICATION I certify that I have read this application and state that the above information is correct and that I am the owner or the duly authorized agent of the owner. I agree to comply with all city and state laws relating to building construction. I hereby authorize representatives of this City to enter upon the above-mentioned property for inspection purposes.
