Minimum Qualifications

Must be at least 18 years old, currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program in an accredited college or university. Must be committed to work a minimum of eight (8) hrs./week.

Some departments may require the possession of a valid California driver's license.



Placement Process

Applicants who meet the minimum qualifications will be referred to the requesting department. Final selection will be based upon successful interview and approval of the hiring authority. No person shall be appointed to a Volunteer position who is within the chain-of-command of his/her relative by blood or marriage within the first degree.
