Trash Dumpster Fires

On Saturday, November 12, 2016, during the early morning hours, two trash dumpster fires were reported in the north mid-section of the City of Vernon. The first fire was reported in the 3600 block of Soto St. and the second in the 3200 block of 26th St. These incidents occurred within close proximity and it is believed the fires were deliberately set by the same suspects. In addition, there was a similar dumpster fire that was reported nearby in the City of Los Angeles.

The Vernon Police Department is seeking information from the public that may assist in this investigation. The enclosed crime information bulletin depicts the two suspects captured on video surveillance including a brief description of both suspects.
