I understand and agree that should I become aware of any such reason, or should I suffer or experience any of the conditions listed below, I will promptly inform the Chief of Police of the Vernon Police Department.

1. *Suffer an emotional or nervous disorder; or*
2. *Become committed, either voluntarily or involuntarily, to any hospital, mental institution or other facility for the treatment of any mental or emotional disorder for the use of alcohol, drugs or narcotics; or*
3. *Commit or become arrested for any crime involving moral turpitude, domestic violence, dishonesty, the use of narcotics, drugs, alcohol, or other intoxicants, or for the brandishing, discharging or use of any firearm, or otherwise come under the close scrutiny of any law enforcement agency.*

I further declare and acknowledge that the Vernon Police Department, upon my initial retirement as a peace officer, or at anytime subsequent thereto may deny or revoke, for good cause, my privilege to carry a concealed weapon as provided in Penal Code Section 12027. I acknowledge the identification presented to me is property of the City of Vernon and must be surrendered upon request.

I hereby authorize the Vernon Police Department to investigate my past record by conducting a DMV, local record and warrant check. This is in order to ascertain that the information I have provided is true and correct. Providing false information may be a reason to deny or revoke my privilege to carry a concealed firearm.

I am a retired peace officer of the Vernon Police Department and have read the federal requirements as described in the Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act (18 U.S. Code § 926C).

I have read the State of California requirements to carry a concealable firearm as they pertain to a retired peace officer (Penal Code 25450, 25455, 25460, 25475, 26305).

Further, I hereby specifically agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Vernon Police Department, its agents, representatives, or employees, from any and all liability resulting from my carrying and/or use of any weapon allowed under the Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004, including, but not limited to, civil litigation, claims of property damage or injury, including death, and criminal liability.

I recognize that the Vernon Police Department is not legally required to provide me with firearms instruction or a firearms qualification course. In consideration of my participation in any Vernon Police Department firearms instruction or firearms qualification course, I agree as follows:

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Vernon Police Department, its agents, representatives, or employees, for any injury caused by my participation in its or any other qualification process. I further waive any claim for damages against the Vernon Police Department, its agents, representatives, or employees, for any injury suffered by me while participating in a qualification process.

Course of fire for Handgun Qualification 50 Rounds

3 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #1)

Assessment & Response Drill (3 shots): Fire 2 shots at the target chest area and 1 shot at the cranio-ocular scoring area.
Handheld Flashlight Drill (2 shots): Dim the range lighting and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Firing Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the firing side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Support Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the support side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.

5 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #2) same drills as above

Assessment & Response Drill (3 shots): Fire 2 shots at the target chest area and 1 shot at the cranio-ocular scoring area.
Handheld Flashlight Drill (2 shots): Dim the range lighting and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Firing Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the firing side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Support Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the support side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.

7 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #3) same drills as above

Assessment & Response Drill (3 shots): Fire 2 shots at the target chest area and 1 shot at the cranio-ocular scoring area.
Handheld Flashlight Drill (2 shots): Dim the range lighting and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Firing Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the firing side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.
Support Hand Only (2 shots): Hold the handgun in the support side hand and fire 2 shots at the target chest area.

10 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #4)

Barricade Shooting Left Side (3 shots): Step behind the left side of the barricade and fire 3 shots at the target chest area.
Barricade Shooting Right Side (3 shots): Step behind the right side of the barricade and fire 3 shots at the target chest area.

15 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #5)

Barricade Shooting Left Side (3 shots): Step behind the left side of the barricade and fire 3 shots at the target chest area.
Barricade Shooting Right Side (3 shots): Step behind the right side of the barricade and fire 3 shots at the target chest area.

25 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position # 6)

Standing Position (4 shots): Stand in the shooting bay and fire 4 shots at the target chest area.
Kneeling Position (4 shots): Assume the kneeling position of choice and fire 4 shots at the target chest area.

7 – Yard Line Drills (Target Stop Position #3)

Long gun to Handgun Transition (3 shots): Hold the replica rifle or shotgun in a fighting stance. React as if the Long gun had malfunctioned. **DROP** the replica firearm. Draw the handgun and assume a strong two-handed hold. Fire 3 shots to the target chest area.

Scoring System:

Inside vital areas: 5 points
Outside vitals/within silhouette: 3 points
Miss: 0 points

Possible score: 250 points
Passing score: 225 points
