
Important Dates

General Municipal Elections are held the second Tuesday in April of each year

- ballots are mailed mid-March
- last day to register to vote is 15 days prior to election date

Special Elections are called when necessary

- Call the City Clerk for more information




Voting – Who Can Vote?

- Registered to vote
- Signature matches voter registration

Provisional Ballots

- Pink envelopes
- Ensures properly registered voters can vote
 - New voter
 - Vote-by-Mail ballot issued
- 90% are valid and counted
- Protects against voting fraud

- · Fill in the circle to the left of your
- . Don't vote for more choices than
- . You don't have to vote in every race.

Write-In Candidates



- . To add a candidate, fill in the circle to the left of "Write-in Candidate" and write the name on the dotted line
- · A list of qualified write-in candidates is available eleven days before the election at layote net
- Do not write-in a candidate whose name already appears on the ballot.
- · Write-in votes are not authorized for Voter-Nominated offices.
- · A voter is entitled to cast a vote for a qualified Write-in candidate for any Nonpartisan office by writing, on the Write-in portion of the ballot, the name of the qualified candidate.

Voter-Nominated And **Nonpartisan Offices**

All voters, regardless of the party party preference, may vote for any candidate for a voter-nominated or preference, if any designated by a candidate for a voter-nominated office shown for the information of the candidate is nominated or endorsed



Question Can people find out who I voted for?

• No. How you vote and who you vote for is confidential.

Question Can someone watch me fill out my ballot?

• Not unless you want them to.

Question What do I do if I don't receive my ballot?

- Contact the City Clerk
- Come to City Hall
