## BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 15-20 years of age\*
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA in school
- Submit a physician-completed Medical/Physical Exam Form
- Ability to read, write, and comprehend directions and training materials in English.
- Ability to work as a team member.
- For everyone's health and safety and pursuant to LA County policies, all Explorer Program participants will be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination

The Fire Explorer program introduces the youth of Los Angeles County to today's fire and emergency medical services. Emphasizing community service and civic involvement through positive mentoring, training, education, and career development. After meeting the program's entrance requirements, participants will be given an opportunity to attend a two-day orientation. We look forward to you joining our Explorer program and exploring all the possibilities!

\*Explorer Program participants 18 to 20 years of age will be subject to a background investigation conducted by Learning for Life.
