PRE-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND ELECTION DAY CANVASSING (For Vote by Mail ballots received prior to or on Election Day)

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(a), processing of Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes (verification of signature and address and updating voter records) may begin 29 days before the election, and will commence Monday, March 13, 2023, at 7:00 a.m., City Hall City Clerk Department. Vote by Mail ballot return envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. To determine if ballot processing will take place on a particular day, call (323) 583-8811, ext. 546.

The Canvass and Count of the Vote by Mail ballots (those received on or prior to Election Day which have been processed) will commence Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at 8:01 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber.

POST-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND CANVASSING (For Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots received on Election Day and Vote by Mail ballots received up to seven days following the election, with postmarks on or before Election Day)

The post-election day Canvassing of Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots will commence on Wednesday, April 12, 2023, 7:00 a.m., City Hall City Clerk Department. Vote by Mail ballot return envelope and Provisional ballot envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. To determine if ballot processing will take place on a particular day, please call (323) 583-8811, ext. 546.

The post-election day count of the 2nd batch of Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots will commence Thursday, April 13, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber.

A second post-election day count for the 3rd batch of Vote by Mail ballots will commence on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber. If an additional count is necessary, it will commence Monday, April 24, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., at City Hall Council Chamber.
