**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that an All-Mail Ballot General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Vernon on Tuesday, April 9, 2024, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

**Measure X**

Shall the measure establishing a ten percent (10%) transient occupancy tax to fund general services in the City of Vernon, such as street and sidewalk repairs, public safety, and City health services, to be paid by hotel guests staying within the City of Vernon, providing an estimated \$84,539 annual revenue for general government use until ended by voters, with all funds locally controlled, be adopted?	<b>YES</b>

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 9281–9295, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure(s), no later than November 21, 2023, 5:30 p.m.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, no later than December 4, 2023, 5:30 p.m.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, arguments and rebuttal arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the filing deadlines.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any ordinance, impartial analysis, direct argument and rebuttal arguments will be available for public examination for 10 calendar days following the submittal deadlines in the City Clerk Department, 4305 South Santa Fe Avenue, Vernon, CA 90058 and on the City’s website.
